Your job is to be the first person to make their way home to safety.

You will each take it in turns to roll the dice to travel through Get Ready Town.

Each place you travel through has a different tip for Getting Ready, which I will read out to you along the way.

Be careful though because you never know when disasters will strike and you may experience some set-backs along the way. But don't worry, if you have the right plans in place, your journey home will be much faster and safer.

Good luck everyone!

- 1 Make sure you have a place to keep your pets safe in a disaster if you have to evacuate.
- 2 Have a plan for evacuating your pets in a disaster that includes how you will transport them, and where you will take them to.
- 3 Name two disaster risks in your neighbourhood to climb the ladder.
- 4 Remember to listen to local warnings and advice before you travel, because you never know when the weather will change.
- 5 Look out! You are approaching a mudslide. Turn the car around and move back to the barn on space 2.
- 6 It's important to protect boats and cars from disasters by moving them to safe ground.
- 7 Remember when you're on holiday to check the disaster risks in the place you're visiting.
- 8 Name one thing needed for your Household Emergency Plan and you can climb the ladder.
- 9 Make sure your insurance for your home and personal belongings is up-to-date so they can be replaced or repaired if damaged in a disaster.
- 10 Name one thing you can do to prepare your pet for a disaster to climb the ladder.
- 11 It's a good idea to check on elderly neighbours in case they need some help in a disaster.
- 12 Stay safe by staying away from creeks or drains during a storm or flood.
- 13 Talk to your family about having a meeting place in case you get separated in a disaster?
- 14 Look out! A storm is coming. Head back to the holiday home on space 6.
- 15 Name one thing you can do to prepare your backyard for storm season to climb the ladder and win the game!
- 16 Remember if it's flooded, forget it. It's dangerous to drive in floodwaters.
- 17 Workplaces and schools need plans so everyone knows what to do in a disaster including evacuating safely.
- 18 Regular maintenance on your home like cleaning the gutters will help keep your possessions safe in a disaster.
- 19 Have a supply of medications in your Emergency Kit in case you can't access the chemist in a disaster.
- 20 Look out! You are approaching a bushfire. Head back to your Aunt's house on space 9.
- 21 Parents should arrange a friend or family member to collect children from school or daycare if they get stuck in a disaster.
- 22 Look out! If it's flooded forget it! Head back to your family meeting place on space 13.
- 23 Have 3 days of food supplies in your Emergency Kit in case the shops are closed in a disaster.
- 24 You made it home safely! Congratulations!
